


We look forward to the spring term when we are offering free parent and pre-school children shared yoga and storytelling sessions in January. Posters with further information are displayed around the village.







A couple from the past...



WOODBURNING STOVES

A lot of publicity has been given recently to woodburning stoves. People are buying them assuming that there will be an endless supply of firewood to feed then. Elm disease has been with us for six years of so and shows no sign of decreasing. With no elm left, where is the wood to come from? Local log merchants can be found but their prices are going up and will continue to do so, but even so will never reach the price of other forms of solid fuel.

How about your own wood lot? This is a good idea if you are a landowner and are prepared to manage a small wood to this end. About two acres are required for a continuous supply for one stove.

The most critical thing about a stove is the chinney. If you have an existing chimney then this will normally be sufficient but mey cause trouble with the formation of tar. Wood produces more tar than other fuels, especially if green or wet. One way to ease this is to fit a stainless steel chimney or liner. These hold the heat better and therefore reduce the tarring. If you cut your wood about 12 months in advance and store in a dry shed then you will get much better heat and stove performance. Stoves in all their forms are efficient and economical in the amount of wood that they burn and a size and type can be found to suit most houses and pockets. <u>B.M.W</u>.

Oak will warm you well If they're old and dry. Larch logs of pinewood smell, But sparks will fly. Beech logs for Christmas time; Yew logs heat well; 'Scots' logs it is a crime For anyone to sell. Birch logs will burn too fast, Chestnut scarce at all; Hawthorn are good to last If cut in the Fall. Holly logs burn like wax; You should burn them green. Elm logs like smouldering flas No flame to be seen. Pear logs and apple logs, They will scent your room. Cherry logs across the dogs Smell like flowers in bloom. But ash logs all smooth and grey,

Burn them green or old; Buy up all that come your way They're worth their weight in gold.
