Drainage Maintenance Responsibilities

At our recent Town and Parish Conferences, a great deal of interest was shown in a display identifying who is responsible for maintaining and clearing drainage systems on and around the highway.

The driver for having the display was a recognition that, for a number of years, we had been investing significant funds undertaking a programme of ditch clearance works to drain the water from the highway. In the majority of cases, the responsibility for ditch maintenance rests with the adjacent landowner, even if the ditches take water from the highway and local authority funding is being used to undertake works which are, in part, the responsibility of the landowners, reducing the funding available to undertake the works which are our responsibility.

In order to support landowners, and local communities, we are undertaking a programme of communication and education with key stakeholders. Hopefully, as a follow up to the recent display at the Parish and Town Conference you will find the following information and resources useful.

 A factsheet titled Roads and farmers is produced by Devon County Council and is available <u>here</u> (https://www.devon.gov.uk/roadsandtransport/factsheet/roads-and-farmers/)

Equally, Landowners and occupiers are required, by law, to trim any hedge next to the public highway where the growth is preventing the passage, or affecting the safety, of the highway user.

 Information regarding overgrown vegetation is available on our website <u>here</u> (https://www.devon.gov.uk/roadsandtransport/maintaining-roads/trees-andvegetation/overgrown-vegetation/) You will also find enclosed a diagram giving an indication of responsibility for the maintenance of drainage and vegetation on and around the highway. We have certainly found this a useful diagram when trying to explain the various issues of responsibility.

I hope you find this information helpful and are able to use it within your communities to support us as we continue to maintain the drainage systems within the highway.

Dear All

This term has been a very busy but also extremely productive one for the school. We have welcomed 5 new children into the K52 class.



As part of the curriculum work looking at WW2, the whole school travelled into Exeter by train and had a Red Coat tour of the areas in the city that were bombed during the war. They were able to see how the city has changed following post-war development. Our guides were extremely knowledgeable about their subject.

Many of our families have been able to bring in artefacts to help the children understand the hardships endured by people in this country, as well as showing the children uniforms and photographs of family members who took part in the conflict. The KS1 role play area has been transformed into an Anderson shelter, and the children have discussed the weekly ration of food that was allowed for a family. We are all looking forward to our visit to the Fleet Air Arm museum in Somerset in March.

In other areas of school life, KS1 have taken part in a couple of nature walks around the village, linking with their work on poetry; they have planted a range of vegetables to be harvested later in the year and have looked at measurements. In art we have looked at the work of Kandinsky and have been busy creating characters for a 3D animation project.

We held a junior Bake-Off competition with Mr Ching as our very competent judge. The children entered biscuits, cakes, brownies and flapjack. The standard was very high but two worthy winners were chosen from KS2.





Our story time and yoga sessions proved very popular in the local area with parents and pre-schoolers. We will be holding a series of Forest School sessions for Parents and Toddlers starting on 27th February for 4 weeks from 1:45pm - 2:45pm. Please do pop along with your children to take part in these activity sessions which are free to attend.
